Joseph's brothers were jealous, they did not like the way he talked and seemed to boast about his dreams and so they were horrible to him. They put him in a deep well and wanted to kill him. They did not kill him but sold him to some men from another country. He really suffered for a long time but he still trusted God. He even spent years in prison but God rescued him. Amazingly, years later, God used his life to help thousands of people in Egypt, including his family to have enough food to survive. A bit like Joseph, we may be going through a difficult time at the moment. Because of the coronavirus we are not able to go out to our schools, to work or to play with others. But we know that God, our heavenly Father and our loving Saviour will work things out for good if we are patient and love and trust in him.




Joseph re-united with his father Jacob.








Because of the famine in Canaan, Jacob sent his sons to Egypt for grain. There they met their brother, Joseph.
