### Paul and Silas

Paul and Silas were in 'lockdown'! They had been thrown into prison, and not only were they confined to a small cell but they were also in chains. However they knew that God was with them. So what did they do? They kept on praying and singing God's praises and thanking God for who He is and everyone in the prison could hear them singing God's praise.





Later Paul wrote to the Thessalonians saying,

"Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances"

1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

... and that's exactly what he and Silas had done in prison in Philippi.

Then, SUDDENLY, there was an earthquake... their chains fell off, the jail doors were open and they were free!

What did they do next? Did they jump up and run out of the prison?

NO, they stayed where they were..... they heard the Jailor calling out, he was scared, he thought the prisoners had all escaped and he knew he would be in big trouble with the Romans

BUT Paul said, "Don't worry we are still here!"

What happened next was even more amazing. The jailor had heard them singing and praising God and he wanted to know how he could be saved and he became a Christian .... and all his family became Christians too.

AND .... the next morning the Roman officers sent orders to let Paul and Silas go free.

We may still be in 'lock down' and things may be difficult but like Paul and Silas we can keep on praying and keep on praising God.


