"What do I need to do so that I can live forever?"


"What does God say?" Jesus replied.

BUT... then the Levite turned away, walked across the road and passed by on the other side! The poor man must have been giving up now. He must have thought that no one would help him.






After a long while the man saw someone else coming down the road. Maybe this person would help.


