Simeon and Anna's Story - A True Story about Jesus as a baby


These two stories are in the Gospel of Luke 2:22-40.



A little while after Jesus was born, Jesus was taken to the temple to be dedicated to God.



Mary and Joseph took Him to the temple in Jerusalem for the special dedication called Purification. Mary and Joseph also bought two small birds to offer to God as a sacrifice. At this ceremony He was named Jesus, the name the angel had told Joseph to give God's Son.



There was an old man in Jerusalem called Simeon. The Holy Spirit told Simeon to go into the temple. God had told him he would not die until he had seen the Saviour.



When Simeon saw baby Jesus he was filled with joy.



Simeon took Him in his arms and praised God that he had seen his Saviour.



Jesus would be a **light** to the Gentiles and the <mark>glory</mark> of His people Israel! Mary and Joseph were amazed at these words.



Simeon also said that some people would reject Jesus, but others would be filled with joy at knowing Him.



There was also a widow called Anna. She was eighty-four and worshipped in the temple all the time. When she saw Jesus, she also knew He was the promised Saviour of the world and gave thanks to God! Anna told everyone she met about Jesus that He was the answer to their prayers for salvation.

Thinking about the story. When a family has a new baby, they often take him to church to thank God and present him to God. Maybe your parents brought you to be dedicated or christened. Where did Mary and Joseph take baby Jesus? Simeon and Anna were old, faithful people who had loved God for many years. They trusted God, prayed and listened to HIM. They knew one day God would send a Saviour. The Holy Spirit told them that Jesus was not an ordinary baby but was God in human form, born to be the Saviour of the world. They were both truly excited to have seen Jesus. Do you trust God that Jesus is your Saviour?

Our verse:

Faith means being sure of the things we hope for. And faith (in God) means knowing that something is real even if we do not see it.

Hebrews Chapter 11 verse 1.

Simeon and Anna had strong faith in God! We can ask God for strong faith too.



Simeon and Anna Thank God --Luke 2


