

The Centurion's Servant Matthew 8:5-13









Hi my name is Hannah; I am a servant in Capernaum. My master he's an important man you know. Here in Capernaum, he's in charge; he has almost 100 soldiers doing what he asks. Imagine that! I'm just a servant woman, no one much listens to me. Mind you, the master may not be Jewish and he is a Roman but he is a kind master and he treats us very well.
