When she had finished The servant gave her two gold bracelets and said, "This is a gift from my master Abraham. He sent me here to find a bride for his son Isaac.





Thank you God that you are our heavenly Father. Thank you God that you love each one of us so much. Thank you God that you can hear us when we can talk to you.


Thank you God that you don't just listen to our prayers but you answer them.


